Suitable for all ages, the film is entertaining, astonishing and features an inspiring soundtrack.

The enjoyable animated film in the Rubia Coffee Ride is shown exclusively in the new state-of-the-art cinema at the visitor centre. The audience is surrounded by three 15-metre screens with surround sound, putting them in the very centre of the action. The highlight of the experience is the addition of moving seats that move in sync with the action and sound, taking viewers on a thrilling eight-minute journey with Rubia. It's a complete film experience right through to the – spoiler alert! – happy ending.

World-class production

For the production of the animated film, JURA commissioned the Burki Scherer studio. The film's stirring soundtrack was created with sound artists from Promoton, renowned musical theatre composer Moritz Schneider and the 80-strong Bratislava Symphony Orchestra conducted by Robert Emery.
